About the marker

The grave was probably on the Michigan Bluff side of the Canyon, but this is only an assumption. A photo of the marker was taken by Wae Perry, County Museum Curator in the 1950s This was used as our model for the trail wanker. The trail went South from Michigan Bluff. IT Crossed the NF of the MF of the American River about I of a mile down from the Rainbow Bridge. The old Mule Train Bridge is Still there. The trail climbed in zig-zag fashion to here and climbed the crest to Big Oak Flat and Greek Store.
